







Orcun Bastürk

Born in Istanbul in 1977, Bastürk is still studying Cinema and Television at Beykent University. Since his early high school years he has played with various rock and punk groups. He is one of the founders of the Replikas music group. He is also involved in theatre, working with Lale Müldür and Nadi Coker on the music for Büyük Ünlü Uyumu, and with Prof. Sabri Özaydın on the music for Balina Müziği. He has also produced the music for Biyolojik Meyzular, directed by Melih Koyuncuoğlu, and participated in Sahte Kimlikler and Margaret Walker's Problem staged by Kumpanya Theater Company. He is one of the founders of the Kırıka group which represented Turkey at the 10th European and Mediterranean Young Artists Biennial held in Sarajevo in 2001.

Gökce Akcelik

Born 1977, he is currently studying Tactile Design at Yıldız Technical University Faculty of Art and Design. He is a member of the Replikas music group which has released two albums entitled Köledoyuran and Dadaruhi since 1993, composed and performed the music for Serdar Akar's film Maruf, and represented Turkey at the 9th European and Mediterranean Young Artists Biennial held in Rome in 1999. Akcelik plays electroacoustic music and has performed with the Replikas group at Borusan in 1999, at Oda: Bir Sanat Mekanı in 2000, and at Bir Dükkan: Sanat Mekanı in 2001 and 2002.

Avhan Hacıfazlıoğlu

Born in 1977, Hacıfazlıoğlu graduated in Radio, TV and Cinema Studies at Marmara University. Between 1996 and 1999 he worked for various channels, and between 2000 and 2002 worked as assistant producer to Serdar Akar on the television serials Yeraltında Dünya Var, Maruf and Koçum Benim.

Barıs Doğrusöz

Born in 1978, Doğrusöz is studying for his master's degree at the Ecole des Beaux-Arts de Mulhouse. He participated in Basel-Mulhouse/Mulhouse-Basel at the Basel Kunst Akademie in 2000, in 'Un pave dans la marre? Quoi de neuf en Architecture?' in Strasbourg, France, in 'Des hauts et des Bas' at Centre Rhenan d'art Contemporain d'Altkirch, and in 'Encombrement Maximal 1' with Niek Van de Steeg at the Hall de l'ecole des Beaux-Arts de Mulhouse in 2001. He held two exhibitions at Galeri de Quai in Mulhouse in 2001 and 2002, and performed with Replikas at Bir Dükkan: Sanat Mekanı. In 2002 he participated in a mixed exhibition entitled 'The Beginning: Different Approaches to Drawing' at Sabancı University's Kasa Gallery, and commenced work on a performance entitled Music Box with Replikas.





Untitled (or, there's always free cheddar in a mousetrap)

How can we tell the truth, the probable truth and the future truth; how can we talk about truth in general? If truth, as Serge Daney says, is what does not return, narrative, before being the vision of what might happen next and hypothetical truth, is the witness of what has happened, the witness of the here and now. And just as we can explain the world by means of a love story in a novel, so we can explain it and its up-to-dateness by means of a video project. As in literature, reality depends on details, and in this form realistic narrative remains true to life down to its smallest details, to its most intrinsic or most superfluous expressions.

Maya is a project group formed in 2001 by Deniz Cuylan, Güney Kurdak and Cem Aykut, playing jazz, electronic and drum'n bass music. The group's members have been playing together since 1994, when they met at St Joseph's Lycée. They named the group Maya in 2001. The group played jazz-rock and fusion music as high school students, but from 1999 onwards began to be influenced by different types of music and different disciplines. The influence of electronic music began to dominate the group's sound, acoustic instruments and electronic sounds balancing one another. In 2002 Aylin Güngör and Volkan Gürkan joined the group, whose new structure required visual performance and sound engineering. Their music is an experimental process of seeking and finding.

Deniz Cuylan

Born in 1979. Currently studying City and Regional Planning at Mimar Sinan University. Plays electric and acoustic guitars, clarinet and synthesiser.

Güney Kurdak

Born in 1978. Studying Architecture at Yıldız Technical University. Plays double bass, electric bass and synthesiser.

Born 1977. Studying for his master's degree in International Relations at Galatasaray University. Plays drums and percussion.

Volkan Gürkan

Born 1975. Studied sound engineering in Germany. The group's computer programmer and sound technician.

Aylin Güngör

Born 1980. Studying City and Regional Planning at Mimar Sinan University. Produces the visual materials and video-art used by the group during live performances.
