Sabancı University presents young artists from Turkey participating in the Biennial of Young Artists from Europe and Mediterranean. Sabancı University is a private university in Istanbul, that has been active since 1999 and includes programs in Social Sciences, Visual Arts Engineering and Natural Sciences.

Sabancı University is committed promoting and supporting young artists and designers from Turkey and abroad.

In addition to the graduate and undergraduate degree programs in visual arts and visual communication design, a contemporary art space, 'Kasa Galeri' has been established in 1999 in Minerva Han where Sabancı University has started its early operations. The building was built as a bank at the beginning of 20th century at Karaköy, one of the most historical and busy districts of Istanbul, and housed many corporations since then. The vault chambers situated at the basement of the building have been transformed into an art gallery under the name Kasa which literally means 'vault' in Turkish.

From the beginning endorsing and exhibiting works by emerging young artists and designers have been the main focus and policy of the gallery. With this in mind, the first exhibition of the gallery was called 'Winds into the Future' featuring works by young artists, later became a yearly exhibition series. The gallery program as a whole is organized as series that include art, design, photography and drawing exhibitions annually. Ther is also a series called 'masters' where works of widely known and acclaimed artists from Turkey and abroad are shown. After accomplishing over 45 shows in the past 9 years, Kasa Galeri has a progressive and credible reputation in Istanbul's artistic environment. While exhibiting works of national and international artists, Kasa is also an active center where lectures, workshops and seminars on art and design are held.

Choreographer/New media artist Beliz Demircioglu Cihandide has moved her base from New York City to Istanbul in 2006. She has received her MPS degree from Interactive Telecommunications Program and her BFA from Tisch School of the Arts Dance Department both at NYU. Her multimedia dance piece "Vantage Point" (in collaboration with Jamie Allen) was selected by Mikhail Baryshnikov for a residency at the Baryshnikov Art Center. Her INTOUCH project became the first interactive installation to be exhibited at the United Nations Headquarters. Her video/installation and multimedia dance works have been showcased at Codice-Idee per la Cultura, Eyebeam Gallery, Jack H. Skirball Center, Bushwick Arts Project, Vancouver NIME, Ask the Robot, and Kasa Galeri among other venues. In 2007 she has showcased her work at Tedance Festival (Lisbon) and Tanzquartier Wien. In the summer of 2008 she will be in residency at L'animal a l'esquena (Celrà).
